Utility Work Continues

As everyone is well aware, we have a lot of utility work going on in our neighborhood. The main work is storm drain improvements, but water and gas lines are also being upgraded and relocated in some areas. There are four work areas right now: Shoal Creek, Lewis Lane, and 40th and 46th streets. Here's some information provided by the project to the neighborhood association about each area:

On Shoal Creek and 46th streets:

In this area, the water line work should be finishing about now. This will be followed by the installation/repair of some individual water service lines. The storm drain work will be starting soon, either on Shoal Creek or on $46^{\rm th}$; this heavy work will involve some lane closures on Shoal Creek over the next few weeks. The gas company is also relocating gas lines on $46^{\rm th}$ and $40^{\rm th}$ Streets.

Lewis Lane:

The storm drain work is still ongoing on Lewis Lane from 40th street to 42nd street. This work will require some 24-hour road closures of Lewis Lane. Driveways on Lewis Lane may be blocked during the day. At night there will be driveway access, although the street will not be fully opened. A second crew, working behind the storm drain crew, will soon be installing a water line and individual water service lines in this area, with work scheduled to be completed by mid-July. When work is completed, the street will be repaved and disturbed lawns will be restored. No one, including residents, may park on the street in the blocks that are immediately under construction between 6:30am and 7:00 pm.

On 40th Street:

Here the wastewater lines have been completed and waterline installations are mostly complete. When the water line work is complete, the storm drain work will begin (a few weeks away). As on Lewis Lane, the storm drain work will be more disruptive than the earlier work.

It's a mess! Be careful. It will surely all be worth it to have well-drained streets ... when (if?) it ever rains again ...



Texas Gas Service Maintenance

During June, Texas Gas Service (TGS) started planned maintenance and work to upgrade its natural gas system in the Rosedale neighborhood that will cause some short interruption of service and temporarily affect traffic. TGS has two separate projects underway in the neighborhood.

The first project is to replace 6,800 feet of natural gas main and related services (the pipe that connects the main to the yardline, which serves the house). The streets to be affected include:

- Shoalwood, between 44th and 45th streets
- Sinclair, from 41st through 48th streets
- Ramsey, from 41st through 44th streets
- Rosedale, from 42nd through 45th streets
- 42nd street between Ramsey and Rosedale
- 44th street between Ramsey and Rosedale
- 46th street between Shoal Creek and Sinclair

Approximately 115 homes will be affected. The gas may need to be shut off at the meter during the time when the new services are connected. Customers will need to be home when TGS restores service. Information on how to get gas service restored promptly will be left with each house.

In addition to the main replacement project, TGS will be relocating sections of pipe and other equipment as part of the City of Austin's CIP project to replace storm drains and perform street reconstruction. In effect, TGS is required to relocate their infrastructure to accommodate the City's work.

The project is planned to include the following streets:

- 47th and Shoal Creek, Shoalwood Ave, Sinclair, Ramsey, and Rosedale
- · 46th and Shoal Creek, Shoalwood Ave
- 44th street and Rosedale through Burnet, Rosedale North and South of 43rd
- 42nd and Rosedale and Burnet to Medical Parkway
- Burnet Road (43rd through 42nd Street)
- Lewis lane from 40th through 42nd street
- 40th street, Ramsey through Rosedale
