# **Lots of** for RAMSEY PARK

WE RAMSEY PARK has been working with neighbors and the City of Austin Parks and Recreation Department for over 2 1/2 years on a plan to transform Ramsey Park.

This summer we completed Phase I and now we are all enjoying freshly resurfaced tennis courts, new seating throughout the park, basketball court upgrades, a wonderful shade structure, and a limestone amphitheater.

As you probably have noticed, construction on Phase II (connecting pathways and stage reconstruction) is under way and Phase III (playscape additions) will commence shortly. The playscape area and multi-use shelter were closed at the beginning of October for construction and we anticipate construction will take 3 to 4 months to complete (weather permitting).

The renovation committee is working closely with PARD and hope to move forward with Phase IV (general infrastructure and landscape upgrades) on the heels of Phase III. We are now within \$7,500 of our \$480,000 fundraising goal thanks to the city, Austin Parks Foundation, businesses and neighbors like you.


